The President welcomed everyone. New members were introduced. We have a quorum.

- Motion made & seconded by Klaas\Doreen: That we rescind the motion made at the general meeting on September 7th, 2008 pertaining to water level due to liability concerns. Carried.
- Motion made and seconded by Dan\Klaas: That the minutes of the general meeting of September $7^{\rm th}$, 2008 be accepted as amended. Carried.
- Old business: Doreen distributed copies of the NEW CONSTITUTION. The name, as is, with (Parry Sound District) added as there is another Nine Mile Lake Cottage Association in Muskoka.
- Motion made & seconded by Fred/Judy: That the new constitution be accepted. Carried.
- Mining Claims: Since last general meeting Klaas and Shirley attended the Toronto session reviewing of the Mining Act. Shirley also wrote the Minister of Northern Development & Mining, Michael Gravelle with a copy to Donna Cansfield, Minister of Natural Resources. Gravelle responded with the usual reassurances. It appears that staking on private land could be 'out' south of the French River but I believe our big concern is the Crown land surrounding our cottages; have also written the Sierra (previously Ecojustice) and Ramsey Hart of MiningWatch Canada. The Municipality of McDougall responded to my letter of November 2008 and said they would look into it in the spring. Again, I wrote them in the spring and they have not responded. There was an article in the North Star news by Evan French who had attended the municipal meeting. Also, I have

written Foca regarding our concerns re the staking so that other cottagers associations may be aware of this problem.

- Lake Water Level: No changes to the status quo for now.
- Camping: Suggested that individual cottagers report irresponsible behaviours and activities to the appropriate authorities.
- Secretary/Treasurers Report:

- Motion made & carried Shirley/Bob: That the report of the Secretary Treasurer be accepted.Carried

- Motion made & seconded Bob/Klaas: That a \$50.00 donation be made to the Nordic Ski Club as a goodwill gesture. Carried. (Roman will deliver the donation).
- Motion made and seconded by Larry/Debbie: That the annual general meeting be held on the Sunday of the Civic Holiday August 1, 2010 at the Pate cottage. Carried.
- New business: Our practice of electing officers for a 3 year term opened the office of Vice President for election.
- Motion made and seconded by Dan/Klaas: That having volunteered and there being no further nominations, we acclaim Doug Hiltz as Vice President for the next term. Carried.
- Discussion for a future date: We should perhaps consider joining WRAFT (I believe it is a coalition after tax reform for waterfront properties). Terry Rees, the ex-director of Foca, is the spokesman. Fee to join is \$50 for an association our size. Ontario, according to one organization, has the highest property taxes in the western world. - Doreen brought information pamphlets and talked briefly about endangered species in our area.
- Klaas reported on his attendance as voting member at the FOCA Annual Meeting. Our Minister of Natural Resources, Donna Cansfield spoke and hinted that Crown land would be released again in the near future. Klaas has written to his MPP for clarification on this subject.
